Our bodies are made up mostly of water.

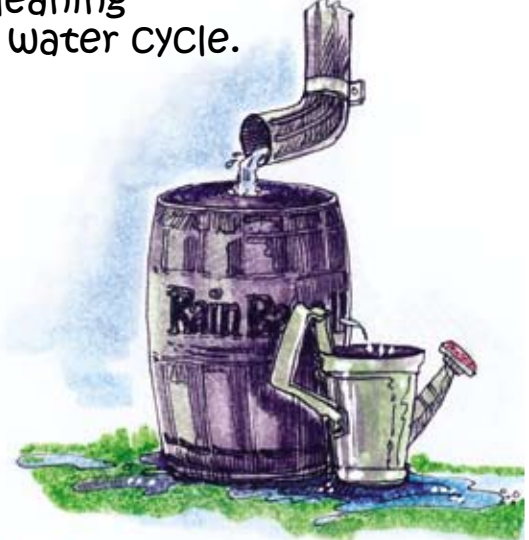
Business is also part of the water cycle.
