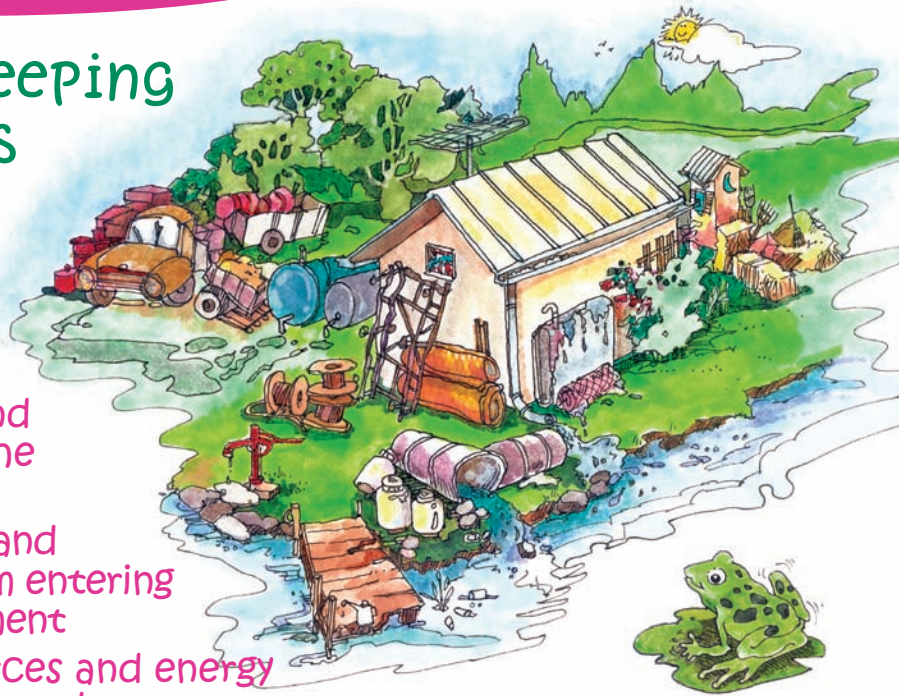

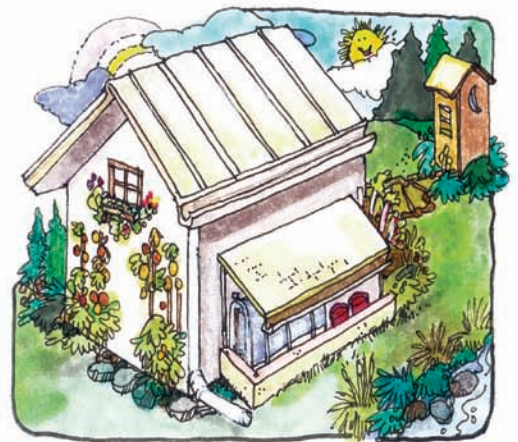

What do you need in order to improve housekeeping?

Good Housekeeping means:

- following preventative maintenance schedules
- fixing equipment promptly
- keeping your work area clean and orderly
- deciding storage location by considering the environment
- where are the drains?
- how does storm water move on site?
- are materials stored away from water courses, wetlands, ditches and catch basins, drainage areas?
- designating areas for recyclables, wastes, and all dangerous goods
- labelling and storing in appropriate containers
- preventing spills and leaks and cleaning up promptly when they occur
- enclosing material transfer points to minimize releases
- ensuring everything has a place.

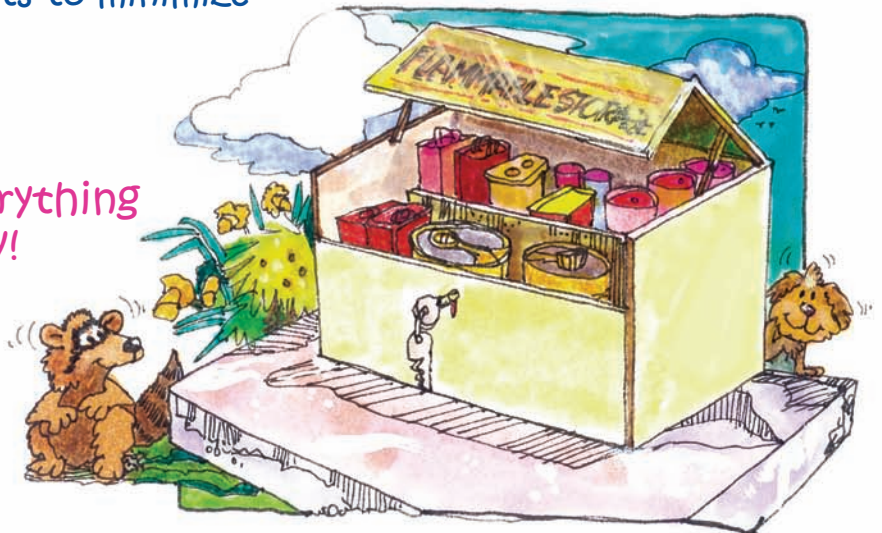
